

Project *Jelly-Fish*: B.R.N.O. Observations of Semiregular Variable Stars (Abstract)**Petr Hajek**

Abstract Brno Regional Network of Observers (BRNO) is a group which prefers to observe eclipsing binary stars. A team called the *Jelly-Fish* has been formed within BRNO for the purpose of observing variable stars other than eclipsing binaries. The observations by *Jelly-Fish* members are predominantly visual; CCD observing has started only recently and such observations are not yet included in our statistics. *Jelly-Fish* has about twenty members at this moment. This paper presents preliminary results based on *Jelly-Fish* observations of S Camelopardalis, AU Camelopardalis, WZ Cassiopeiae, RS Cygni, T Persei, RU Persei, and R Ursae Minoris.
