

### **Photoelectric Photometry At Szeged Observatory (*Abstract*)**

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**Abstract** Extensive photoelectric photometry was carried out at Szeged Observatory using the 0.4-m Cassegrain-type telescope with an SSP-5A photometer during 1994–1997. We have observed mainly pulsating stars (Cepheids,  $\delta$  Scuti-type variables), although eclipsing binaries have been observed as well. As the observatory lies in a moderately light-polluted environment, we outline a possible way that small observatories can pursue scientific projects using *UBV* and *uvby* photometry.
